Nominations for the Board of Directors for the LFIA are now open.

Applications will be accepted anytime before Wednesday 29 October 2014. Applications forms are available from the LFIA website or at the email address below. All applicants will need to be members of the LFIA (you can join on line at https://living-future.org/membership-options) and must be nominated by any two other LFIA members.

The LFIA is seeking professional, ethical, knowledgeable and hard-working Board members who are passionate about a living future.

The Board of Directors will select voluntary board of Officers, including:

- Fundraising Chair
- Education Chair
- Advocacy Chair

Experience and knowledge in fundraising and advocacy is very desirable.

Nominations will reviewed by the current Directors to ensure they accord with these parameters. Should there be more candidates nominated than there are vacancies, balloting lists will be prepared containing the names of the candidates in an order determined by lot. The ballot will take place at the Annual General Meeting, which will occur on Friday 29 November 2014. Each Member is entitled to vote for any number of candidates not exceeding the number of vacancies. If there are no more candidates nominated than there are vacancies, then the chairperson of the Annual General Meeting will declare those candidates elected as Directors.
